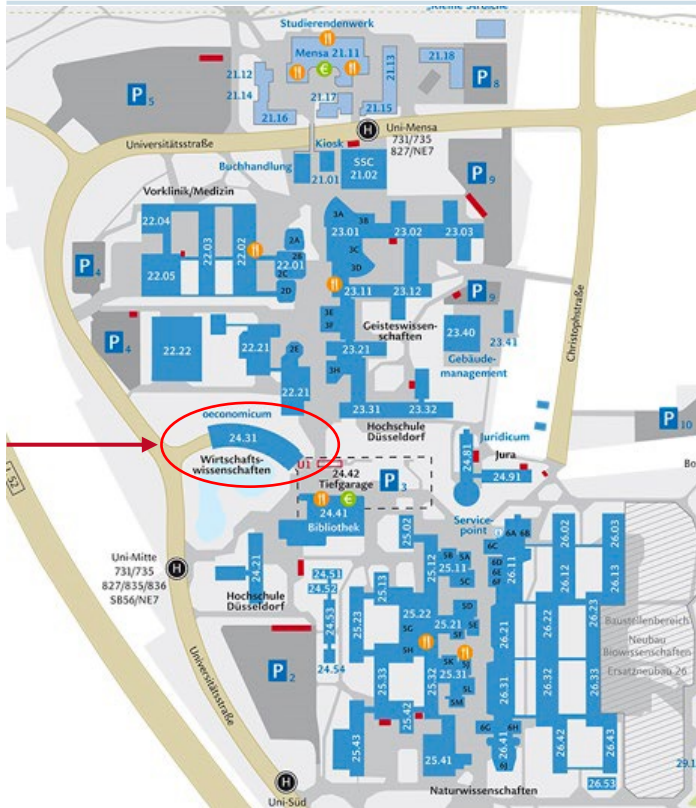

- Master programs comprise 120 ECTS
 - 30 ECTS per semester when studying within standard time of study
- Standard time of study: 4 semesters
 - Winter semester: 1.10. – 31.03.
 - Summer semester: 01.04. - 30.09.
- Exams usually take place in
 - February/March (1st/2nd exam date) and
 - July/September (1st/2nd exam date)
- Usually, attendance is not compulsory but highly recommended
 - Individual responsibility!
- **IMPORTANT:**
 - You alone are responsible for your timetable
 - Pay attention to course application deadlines

Core & Elective Modules

Note that not all modules are offered each semester, usually modules are offered either in the winter OR in the summer semester

- Courses usually consist of lectures AND exercises
 - Both are relevant for your exams
 - Lectures: usually 1 fixed appointment per week or block seminar
 - Exercises: in some cases more than 1 appointment per week to choose from

- Please be aware of deadlines for exam registration (are posted [online](#))
 - Registration via [Student's Portal](#)
 - Registration period usually 2-3 weeks in May/December
 - Afterwards, no registration possible
- Withdrawal of registration up until 7 days previous to exam without giving explanations (online)
 - Afterwards only in urgent cases, such as illness (certificate needed, must be issued on the day of the exam; [check online](#) for the necessary documents)
- You have three attempts per module, if you fail the third time you will be ex-matriculated
 - Usually one exam date per semester
 - 2 dates per semester for elective modules, but only in semesters where the course is offered!
 - If you fail for the second time, the third try must be within 15 months after second try

If there are problems or discrepancies, immediately contact the Student and Examination Administration!

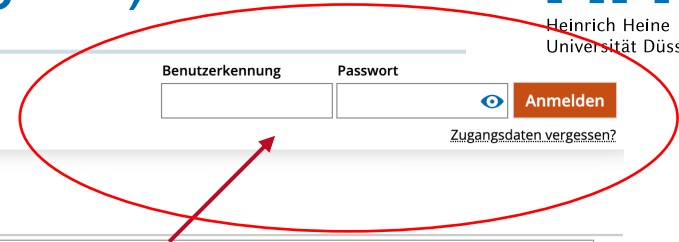
